



I am drawn in by their personalities, which inspires their names and gives them new life. The appeal reaches across generations, as they are Artistic,



Find Your Creative Voice Painting with Marilyn Rose Fall/Winter 2024 - 25



Do you enjoy being in a class for camaraderie and to keep you painting? Is your art stuck at a certain level that you can't seem to get past? Are you feeling uninspired and frustrated with what you are making? 

Winter Oil Painting Studio: 8-Week Session / Matt Pectol


