

Deena Riley Millecam was raised on a fruit farm in Payson, Utah. She learned from her father, Howard Riley, how to work hard pruning, irrigating, fertilizing and harvesting fruit.

Because of this upbringing, she learned life skills of working hard to accomplish what you want.

Deena graduated from Utah State with a Bachelor of Education, and received her Masters from the University of Utah in Education and Administration. She was an art teacher, special education teacher, school counselor and later became an administrator for Uintah School District.

After many years in education, she returned to art - teaching adults, at-risk students, and young people. She now shows in four galleries; Gallery 35, Red Cliff Gallery, Gallery 25 in Ogden, and Arrowhead Gallery.

She attributes her watercolor and oil painting to many great art mentors that have supported and taught her art.



Youth Weaving Workshop

Wednesday July 9, 1:30-2:30pm Washington City Library Community Room 220 N 300 E in Washington UT

An opportunity for youth, ages 8-12, to learn the heritage art of weaving. Best of all, it's FREE! Limited to 20 youth - early registration is recommended.

Young artists, ages 8-12, will have the opportunity to learn the basics of weaving by creating their own small examples. Each participant will be provided with a cardboard loom, two skeins of yarn, and 2 plastic needles. They will go home with their project, their remaining yarn and needles, along with instructions explaining how to complete their weaving and/or start another one at home. This event is sponsored by the Washington City Arts Council and supported by Washington City RAP Tax. Limited to 20 youth participants and an adult helper. Each child must be accompanied by a teen or adult who will assist them as they create their weaving.
