The Art Guild is Growing

In the last few months there have been a lot of changes and growth within the Art Guild. We have been offered several opportunities to participate in local events.

Our SubClubs, are growing in scope and participants. The exhibition we held at Red Cliff Gallery attracted about 200 entries - more than what we anticipated when we first planned the event. The quality of the exhibits were high and reflected the wide scope of interests and skills of our members.

St George City invited the Arts Alliance group - of which we are a founding member - to participate in an event "Dinner on Main" as part of the Dixie Days Celebration - a huge success last year. This year, they closed Main St between St George Blvd and Tabernacle and invited us to display some art as part of the Alliance. The invite was last-minute, but I am grateful to our members who volunteered to help at short notice. Some members did art demonstrations in the restaurants and others helped with art displays by setting up and being available to help during the event. If it proves to be popular, they propose to hold the event again. Next year, we will have more time to plan the event so everything will run smoother.


The Textile artwork of Susan Christensen will be the featured artist during the show.

Laura Keller


Born and raised in Utah, I lived in the Southern Utah area, part-time, for




