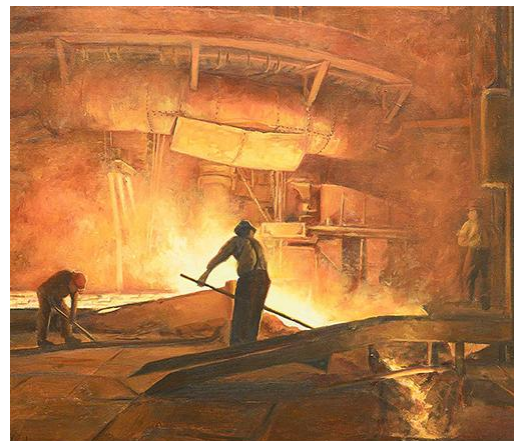

THERE ARE CHANGES - PLEASE READ THE NEW GUIDELINES

1. This show is open to all 2-D and 3-D art mediums. The judges will consider originality, creativity, theme, composition, skill, and technique equally.
2. Red Cliff Gallery encourages artists to create new work. Your art work can be entered again if it's been more than six months from the previous entry date in a Red Cliff show and has never won an award.
3. You may enter up to 3 pieces in the show. \$15 for one piece and \$25 for two pieces and \$25 for three pieces. Checks payable to Southern Utah Art Guild or prepay at: <https://saugevents.eventbrite.com/online-store/red-cliff-gallery-application/>
4. The Show Committee reserves the right to deny any entry based on quality of framing and/or hanging hardware. Art should be consistent with general viewing, no level or violent art.
5. All artwork must be YOUR ORIGINAL ART. No copying from someone else's art or photographs. No prints (framed or otherwise), reproductions, cards, giclée, etc. No pre-printed panels are allowed. Submissions should not be "crafty".
6. The Show Committee will label and hang all work for consistency.
7. SALES - Any sales of artwork displayed in the current gallery, regardless of where else the art image may have been seen, should still be handled through the gallery. When the Red Cliff show is over, your piece will be available for another event or venue.
8. The Guild will retain a commission of 25% of the sale price. Artists should include the Guild's commission in the sale price. Use this formula: Price you desire \$____ x .75 = Sale Price
9. Sales tax will be added to the price of each piece sold and handled by the gallery.
10. It is your opportunity to replace SOLD art as quickly as possible with a new piece with no additional charge to you.

Neither the Southern Utah Art Guild nor the City of St George assume liability for work exhibited during the show.

There is currently a waiting list for Marilyn's weekly class, so this short course will prepare students for when space opens up. It's also a good basis for any class or online painting course.

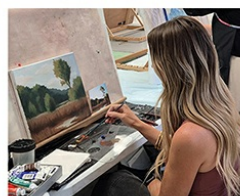
