Colored Pencils SubClub





Color mixing, creating form and depth with values, design and composition and expressive brush and knife work are the main focus of the exercises and mindful practice that benefit oil painters of all levels.

Long-time and newer students have remarked on how this training has benefited their progress and increased their creativity and enjoyment of the painting process.
